

Changes to Travel Plans: 20% Changed During Peak in First Half of 2021

- The percentage of those changing their travel plans in Japan due to COVID-19 increased during the spread of infection throughout 2020. This trend continued in the first half of 2021.
- Month by month, those changing their plans increased to 20% in January 2021, the peak month during the third wave, but decreased to 10% in February 2021 as the number of infections also decreased. However, from April 2021, the number of infections rapidly increased again, and in May 2021, the peak of the fourth wave, those changing their plans increased to just under 20%.

Changes due to COVID-19: Changes to Activities/Destinations Remains at Top

- Excepting August 2020 and January 2021, the most common changes to domestic travel due to COVID-19 were activities and destinations. Changes to accommodation gradually increased from April 2021, exceeding 25% in June 2021 to become the thirdhighest percentage.
- In the first half of 2021, changes in travel destination (domestic to domestic) particularly increased between January to February 2021 and May 2021 during the third and fourth waves.

June 2021: "I Don't Feel Anxious" Exceeded "No Point in Worrying"

- Regarding their feelings surrounding travel during COVID-19, from April 2020 "No point in worrying" accounted for the highest percentage of respondents, however from June 2021 this changed to "I don't feel anxious about COVID-19."
- Focusing on August to December 2020 during the Go To Travel campaign, "Prices are lower than usual" hovered between 15% and 20%. However, from January 2021 onward, the percentage dropped to almost below 10%. During the same period, the number of respondents who answered, "Everything's empty" was less than 10%, but after January 2021, when the campaign was suspended and a state of emergency was declared, this number increased to just under than 20%.

Impressions of Travel in First Half of 2021: 30 - 35% Felt Infection Control was Thorough

- Regarding impressions of domestic travel, for all months during the first half of 2021 "No crowds so it was comfortable" had the
 highest percentage of respondents. The percentage of respondents who answered, "Not much different from before COVID-19"
 dropped sharply to 25% in April 2020, when the first emergency declaration was issued, increasing to 45% by October 2020.
 However, this dropped below 30% again in January 2021, when the second emergency declaration was issued.
- In the first half of 2021, the percentage of respondents who answered that infection control at their travel destinations was "thorough" greatly exceeded the percentage who answered that they were "Not thorough which was concerning." However, this percentage was only 30 to 35%.

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COVID-19 Measures at Destination: More Thorough than in Day-to-Day Life

- In the first half of 2021, "wearing masks" remained the most common measure against COVID-19 during domestic travel, at over 90%. The percentages for "Encouraging use of and thoroughly use alcohol sanitizing sprays installed at places visited" and "Encouraging and thoroughly practicing hand washing and gargling" remained above 70%.
- The percentage of respondents who answered "Not doing anything in particular" has remained below 1% since October 2020 (excluding March 2021). In day-to-day life, this trended at around 1 to 2%¹. It can, therefore, be assumed that respondents are taking the same or even more thorough measures during travel compared to daily life.



10 to 20% Used Travel Discount Support Programs in First Half of 2021

- The utilization rate of the travel discount support system was 75 to 90% in October to December 2020, when Go To Travel was first implemented. However, after January 2021, when it was suspended, only local travel discount support systems implemented by some prefectures and municipalities were available, leading to a utilization rate of 10 to 20%.
- In terms of how these systems were used, more than half of the respondents in all months except February 2021 answered, "I reduced travel costs by using the same level of accommodation and transportation as before COVID-19."
